## Aaron Dubrovner

Rev. Aaron Dubrovner, 462 Alabama, is one of a long line of rabbis and Schochets, the son and grandson of men who filled these offices, in Piathy, Volina. Rev. Dubrovner was born in Rodonisle, Koev, Russia, in 1880. He studied for the profession of his father and grandfather there, until 1900, coming to Tennessee in 1904.

In 1915, he married Mollie Slovatsky, the daughter of Schmuel and Bessie Slovatsky, and they have two children, Feige Amie, 16, and Chaye Goldie, 14. He also had one son, Louis, who died at the age of 34, in 1931, by a previous marriage. Louis was married to Shirley Portnoy, and they had three children, Rosalind, Rachael, and Raphael.

Upon his arrival in Memphis, Rev. Dubrovner had resumed his functions as rabbi and schochet. He has a place of business at 210 North Main. He is connected with Baron Hirsch, Mischne, Anshei Sphard, and Anshei Galicia congregations, and is a member of Sam Schloss Lodge No. 35, B'nai B'rith, and Memphis Lodge No. 286, Progressive Order of the West.
