Abe Cohen is the son of Simon and Frieda Levy Cohen, born in New York City, in 1889. He attended Cheder there, as a small boy, moving with his parents to Memphis in 1895, where he attended the public schools.

His father engaged in the mercantile business at 149 Beale Street, under the title of Simon Cohen and Sons, and he entered the business with his father, assuming charge of it when Mr. Simon Cohen retired.
