

Congregation Anshei Sphard

Congregation Anshei Sphard was organized on Feb. 11, 1904, with S. Kanarek, now dead, as first president. Other original members were S. Dlugach, deceased, S. Baruchman, deceased, N. Kapell, H. I. Schaffer, and S. Weinberg.

The first schul was at 289 Maiden Lane, and services were held there until 1926. A new building was then erected at 289 Market Square, with the building committee composed of N. Kapell, chairman, A. Goldman, vice-chairman, H. I. Schaffer, S. H. Epstein, Sam Dlugach, H. Hyman, and H. Goldman, and an investment of \$26,000 represented.

Present officers are H. I. Schaffer, president, A. Goldman, vice-president; N. Kapell, secretary; S. H. Epstein, treasurer; and the following trustees—J. Ostrov, W. V. Katz, B. Ettingoff, N. Tenenbaum, I. Srebranig, Jake Felt, H. Goldman, I. Feldman, Sam O'Mell, and M. Padawer.
