Harry Lerner is the son of Kolman and Rachael Lerner, and was born in Memphis, in 1872. He was educated in the local public schools, and is now engaged in the local business here, at 174 Beale. His firm is a successor to the Lippman Loan Office. His home is at 138 North Belvedere.
