

Hyman Rosen

(Deceased)

The late Hyman Rosen was born in Vilna, Russia, in 1875. He was educated in the Talmud there, and it was there, also, that he was ordained for the rabbinate by the famous Reb Yitzchok Elkhanon. He came to Memphis in 1905.

He married Freda Kantrowitz, of Vilna, and the couple had five children—Rebecca, who married Max Horowitz, of Birmingham, Ala.; Isadore, associated with Mrs. Rosen in the conduct of Rosen's Kosher Delicatessen, 291 North Main; David Rosen, who was born in 1905 and died in 1917; Bertha, who also assists in the business; Fannie, who is married to Sam Goldstein and has one daughter; and Edward R. Rosen active in Memphis Chapter No. 71, A. Z. A. and the Baron Hirsch Junior Congregation.

Mrs. Rosen is a daughter of Pessach Kantrowitz, who was one of the founders of Memphis' first Talmud Torah. She is a member of various congregations in which Mr. Rosen was known and loved. She is past president of Anshei Sphard Ladies' Auxiliary, member of Congregation Mischne, Jewish Ladies' Aid Society, Senior Hadassah, and Ladies' Auxiliary of Memphis Lodge No. 286, P. O. W.
