Colonel I. C. Lebolt, the son of Rosa and Adam Lebolt, was born in Dayton, Ohio, but left at an early age for Holly Springs, Miss. After staying there for a few years he went to Birmingham, Ala. where he remained for fifteen years. He came to Memphis in 1903 and became interested in the manufacturing of extracts and soda water supplies. In 1918, he retired from active business.
