Isaac Lippman, who died in Memphis on July 20, 1920, was born in Kolo, Russia. He came to Tennessee in 1880, with his wife, the former Pauline Lippe, who died in 1916, and his four children.

Mr. Lippman was the founder of the Lippman Loan Office here. He was active in social and religious activities having been president of Baron Hirsch synagogue, Sam Schloss Lodge No. 35, B'nai B'rith and the Knights of Pythias. Mrs. Lippman, too, was well known for her charitable activities during her lifetime.

The four children are Anna, Mrs. Frank Warhaftig; Minnie, Mrs. Nathan Karnowsky, who has two children Nathan and Rosalind, Rosalind herself married and the mother of twins; Rena, Mrs. Jacob Levy, of Louisville, Ky.; and Morris (see biography).
