

Jacob James Bach

Jacob James Bach was born in Memphis on July 24, 1882, the son of Nathan and Amelia Cohen Bach. His father died in May, 1930, and his mother in June, 1931.

Mr. Bach went to work when he was 13, and was for many years connected with the firm of Goodman and Bach. He went into business for himself in July, 1931, the firm being known as the J. J. Bach Loan Bank.

In 1909, he married Miss Rebecca Bauman, and they have three children, Elvis B., a graduate of the University of Wisconsin, now Mrs. Leonard Schram of Chicago; Jacob James, Jr., who attends high school here and Rose Estelle, still in grammar school.

Mr. Bach is a member of Temple Children of Israel, Sam Schloss Lodge No. 35, B'nai B'rith, Elks, Masons, Shrine, Civic Club, and was one of the founders of the Rex Club.
