Jacob Rosenblum, who was born in Suchovolia, Grodno, in 1873, the son of Zalmon and Leah Rosenblum, came to Tennessee in 1904. In his home city, he attended Cheder until he was 13, and then learned the shoemaking trade. He has continued in this business as a shoe merchant, with his place of business at 332 North Main.

He married Giveh Lashin, who died in 1921, and they had three children, Esther, who is Mrs. Max Friedman, of 264 N. Montgomery, with whom Mr. Rosenblum makes his home; Alex Rosenblum, a merchant in Schlater, Miss.; and Lily, who is Mrs. Harry Person, of Lambert, Miss.
