

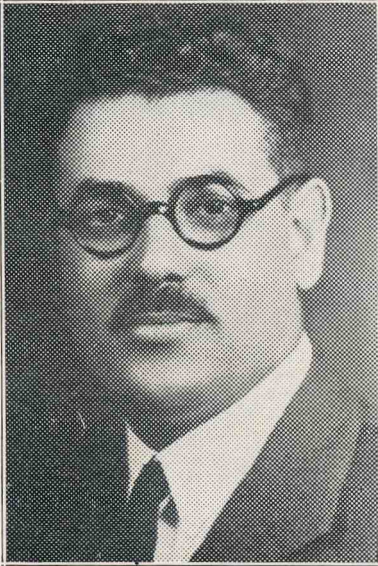
Joseph Krivcher
