Milton W. Goldberger, editor of The Hebrew Watchman and associate editor of Southern Jewry, was born in Memphis, Tenn., on April 11, 1906, the son of Mr. and Mrs. David Goldberger.

Mr. Goldberger received his elementary and high school education in Memphis. He attended the University of Tennessee for three years, and concluded his collegiate career at Ohio State University in the College of Journalism.

He assumed the editorial leadership of The Hebrew Watchman in 1926, and has continued in that position to the present time.

Mr. Goldberger is a member of the Executive Committee of the Sam Schloss Lodge of the B'nai B'riith, and has served the Tennessee State B'nai B'rith as temporary chairman. He has addressed B'nai B'rith gatherings in Tennessee, Arkansas, and Mississippi. He is an advisor of the A. Z. A. Fraternity.

Mr. Goldberger is a member of the Memphis Zionist District, of the Baron Hirsch Synagogue, and has been identified with many campaigns and drives for the relief of suffering Jews thruout the world.
