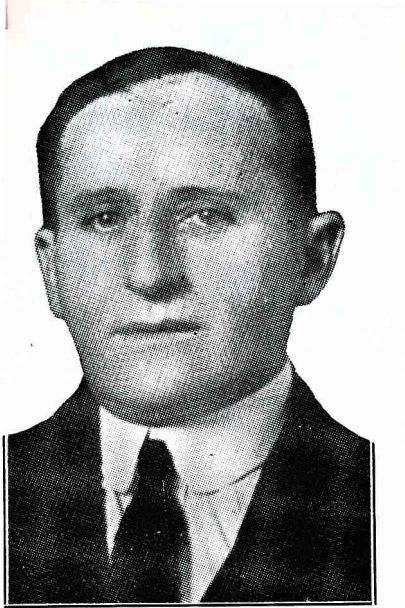


Sam Shainberg

Sam Shainberg is that rare thing, a native New Yorker, but he showed his independence of spirit by his removal to Memphis, in 1901. He was born in New York in 1881, the son of Harry and Hannah Shainberg and went to school there until he was 18.

He started in business, in 1901, in Memphis, in partnership with D. Lewis, who later became his father-in-law.

In 1904, Mr. Shainberg married Miss Elizabeth Lewis, and the couple had five children, four of whom are living. The eldest daughter, Minnie, is the wife of Ben Goldstein, who is associated in business with Mr. Shainberg, as are his two sons, Nathan and Herbert. They have two children, Jerome, 7, and a small daughter. David Shainberg, the eldest son, was killed in the Palestine riots of 1928. Nathan is married to Dorothy Rubin, and they have one son, David. Beatrice is the wife of Ben Leah, and they are the parents of a lovely little daughter. Herbert is unmarried.
